"FOUNDING THE COMMUNITY EDUCATIONAL CENTER FOR ROMANI IN LUNA TOWNSHIP, CLUJ COUNTY"

LUNA TOWNSHIP, in its capacity of project promoter, has signed on November 7, 2014 the financing agreement for implementation of the project entitled "FOUNDING THE COMMUNITY EDUCATIONAL CENTER FOR ROMANI IN LUNA TOWNSHIP, CLUJ COUNTY", financed by means of the Local REQUEST within the program RO10 "Children and Youth at risk and local and regional initiatives to reduce national inequalities and to promote social inclusions", program developed within the Financial Mechanism of European Economic Space (SEE) 2009 – 2014.

This project will be performed in 18 months (from November 2014 to April 2016).

PROJECT PARTNERS: ASSOCIATION FOR PROMOTING SOCIAL INCLUSION AND GYMNASIUM SCHOOL OF LUNA.

This project is financed from non-reimbursable funds in a value of 759.311,78 lei, out of which 645.415,01 lei SEE grant and 113.896,77 lei public co-financing.

The general objective of project consists in developing efficient and effective integrated support services for children at risk of school leaving, in order to promote social inclusion in Luna township, Cluj county.

Reaching the project general objective will help us in accomplishing the general objective of the program - "Strengthening the economical and social cohesion to national, regional and local level" - by creating a single intervention framework through support actions aiming to provide children at risk of school leaving necessary knowledge and skills in order to cope with the labor market requirements on long and short term, to encourage their families to provide them acceptance and support and to solve the potential issues occurred in their families for maintaining the continuity and sustainability of these interventions, to help identifying solutions to community issues, during the community meetings.

All these support measures are meant to be long term interventions aiming to strengthen the cohesion of Luna community, starting from the community nucleus – children at risk of school leaving and their families – that have positive effects on the local economic and social environment.

More precisely, in 18 months of project implementation, the old building of the Luna Gymnasium School will be restored and endowed, being transformed in a day center hosting free of charge services for 75 children of the target group and for their parents.
